## **PRW 2010 Summer and Fall Training Calendar for Law Enforcement in the Rocky Mountain West**

### **GENERAL TOPIC COURSES FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT**

**PRW Digital Camera for Law Enforcement Course--** This one day course is a basic primer in Digital camera usage for patrol operations and investigations. Digital camera settings, composition, macros, downloading, uploading and converting files for not only evidence use but for presentations in both electronic and written forms. Also covered are recommendations for court usage and long term storage of digital evidence. (8 hours) (\$125) classroom for the following dates: SteamBoat Springs Oct 16th, 2010, and Brighton, CO Dec 11th, 2010

**PRW Advanced Tactical Scouting--**a one day advanced classroom only course in pre-warrant raid planning for SWAT, patrol officers, detectives and supervisors. Preparing a detailed scout report and tactical briefing package, use of digital technologies, infrared and covert techniques. This class is a must for anyone involved in pre-raid planning. (10 hours) (\$125) Brighton, CO Date: November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2010

**PRW--Officer Mental Survival—**Spouses attend FREE and we highly recommend they do! "You're trained for this right?"An intense course that discusses the dynamics of the "new enemy" police officers face daily on the street. This course is the best blend of street, career, and home survival available in the law enforcement community. April 16th 2010 Steamboat Springs, CO and Dec 17th 2010 Brighton CO.

**PRW-Medical Triage for Patrol officers-**PRW has combined with ColoradoStar to provide a 4 hour course designed to teach law enforcement officers that find themselves first on-scene, the skill of basic medical triage. It's common for patrol officers to arrive first to a multi vehicle car crash, a bus crash or a mass casualty incident. The several minutes that it takes for an EMS response (typically 9-10 minutes), can be utilized to sort the patients so that when EMS arrives, they can be directed to those in most need that are more likely to survive. Basic skills such as breathing assessment, pulse assessment and mental status assessment are taught, as these are the field diagnostics utilized for the initial assessment of a victim's medical condition. The intent for the course is to augment and supplement the EMS component as well as provide for initial scene organization. This course is Colorado POST approved for 4 hours credit. ### **SWAT/TACTICAL TOPIC COURSES FOR 2010**

**PRW FieldCraft Clinic-**A three day course in sniper fieldcraft. Students will receive a mil-spec ghillie suit kit with tuition and build their own. Students must provide base garment. Classroom and field exercises in an essential skill for police sniper survival. (No live rounds) (simunitions provided) (\$450) August 3-5<sup>th</sup>, 2010 Ruidoso, NM, Oct 6-8<sup>th</sup> 2010 Loveland, CO Already have a ghillie? Attend Fieldcraft at half price to learn tactics. (1.5 days)

**PRW-Advanced Sniper Scenarios-** An advanced sniper school, consisting of three days of real-life based urban and rural scenarios which will test even the most veteran snipers and provide the skills in solving problems. This course includes use of force, legal issues, "when to shoot, not just how", fieldcraft, stalking, tracking, land-navigation, day/night ops and intelligence gathering, There will also be cold bore shots out to 500 yards.(40 Hours) (3.5 days) (\$550)Pre-requisite of PRW Workshop or equivalent sniper basic course. Near Fairplay, CO Oct 28-31st 2010 This is the PRW President's favorite course. Room and Board is included in the tuition. Students stay at the training site 24/7. There is no better deal in the nation for an operational police sniper.

**PRW-Advanced Sniper-** An advanced sniper school and our long awaited sequel to the Precision Rifle Workshop, consisting of four days of Teamwork, stress shooting, long range cold bores, problem solving, spotter/sniper coordination, fieldcraft and counter-sniper tactics. Cold bore shots out to 500 yards, drills out to 1000. (50 Hours)(500 rounds) \$450

**PRW PRECISION RIFLE WORKSHOP –**The "core" school is a five day, 50-hour course that will fulfill the requirements of a "basic police sniper school" with advanced material to include moving targets and shooting exercises out to 1000 yards (Sometimes dependent on range facilities, yardage may vary). Students must pass a written exam and shooting qualification. The "core" school is a pre-requisite for our advanced police sniper schools. This course is in high demand and fills quickly. 50 hours -five days--\$475

**PRW Police Sniper Instructor School-- August 9-13th, 2010 Ruidoso, NM** An advanced sniper school for veterans of the craft. Learn teaching methods for new personnel while working on your own skills. Prepare yourself to lead your team. This course has a written exam, practical test and shooting qualification. Three days on the range and two days in a classroom. 50 hours-Five days-- Tuition is \$650-- Course pre-requisites consist of being assigned as a police sniper for at least three years, Range officer or comparable LE instructor credentials, and attending the core PRW Workshop class, PRW Adv. Sniper Scenarios or PRW Adv. Sniper courses. (Equivalent courses taken with comparable training institutions can be accepted with resume) A letter of recommendation from your Commander is also required.

**PRW 50 BMG SASR Course--** A Special Application Scoped Rifle course for operators. A four day course designed for sniper teams that have decided to implement a SASR program. This course will teach sniper teams the application, capability, limitation and operational skill sets of a SASR system. This will include both a written exam and practical qualification. Upon successful completion of this course, the snipers will be certified as SASR operators. (40 hours) (\$950) (200 rounds) (M2AP recommended) (Rifles can be rented for this course at additional cost) Ammo can be purchased at cost from PRW with advance notice. Students stay and eat on the National Guard base at significantly reduced rates.

**PRW Sniper Command and Control Course-** this course is for police command and supervisory personnel who actively supervise police snipers during SWAT deployments and training. Equipment recommendations, manpower, liability issues, sniper team deployment techniques and selection of personnel are covered during this two day classroom only course. (2 days) (\$400) December 14-15th 2010 Glenwood Springs, CO

**PRW Tactical Life Saver BASIC for Law Enforcement--July 21-22, 2010 Parker, CO-** PRW and ColoradoStar have coordinated for a two day 16 hour Tactical Life Saver Basic training program that evolved to train police officers from SWAT, special units and patrol how to render care to wounded victims while there is an ongoing threat of violence. This course is Colorado POST approved for 16 hours credit. Prior to the arrival of more advanced medical specialists, there is a need for officers to apply the strategies and techniques that have evolved from the specialty of military medicine to save themselves or civilians in the event that they experience a life threatening confrontation. Many of the routine practices in civilian emergency medical training are inappropriate and even dangerous in the tactical environment. (two days) (\$400)

#### **PRW CIVILIAN COURSES**

**PRW Civilian Extreme Long Range Rifle--** Sept 28-30th, 2010 at Guernsey, WY-Bring that .50 BMG, that 300 Win, the .338, or any big game hunting caliber and shoot out to 1500 yards. Learn about wind calls, long range ballistics and build the ultimate drop chart. (\$650) Cost includes room and board

**PRW Metallic Cartridge Reloading Clinic:** Want to learn a new skill and save money on your ammunition needs? This course will enable students with little or no prior experience in reloading to produce safe, consistent, and accurate ammunition. Reloading Safety, components, data, equipment needed and practical exercises where you load your own during this 8 hour course. PRW can teach 2-10 students per clinic, bring a friend, spouse or teenager to this one. \$125 tuition (Students will load example cartridges, if you load your own specific caliber, there may be additional costs) (No firearms needed at this course) Currently offered June 23rd, 2010, and November 3rd, 2010 in the Brighton, CO area.

**PRW Advanced PDA/PC Ballistics-FALL TBA, 2010 Brighton, CO** An advanced course for military, police snipers and civilian long range shooters in the use of computerized ballistics assistants for PC and PDA's typically used in extreme long range shooting. This course covers the typical use of software, downloads and the working knowledge required to use these advanced tools. (8 hours) (\$125)
